REFLECTION

The season of Easter concludes with today's celebration, the feast of Pentecost, when we celebrate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles gathered in the upper room in Jerusalem; this event marks the beginning of the Church.

Today's Gospel reminds us about the integral connection between the gifts of peace and forgiveness and the action of the Holy Spirit. Jesus greets his disciples with the gift of peace. Jesus then commissions his disciples to continue the work that he has begun, "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." As he breathes the Holy Spirit upon them, Jesus sends his disciples to continue his work of reconciliation through the forgiveness of sins.

This Gospel reminds us that the Church is called to be a reconciling presence in the world. This reconciling presence of Christ is celebrated in the Church's sacramental life. In the Sacrament of Baptism, we are washed clean from sin and become a new creation in Christ. In the Sacrament of Penance, the Church celebrates the mercy of God in forgiving sins. This reconciling presence is also to be a way of life for Christians. In situations of conflict, we are to be agents of peace and harmony among people.

ST. ANTHONY OF PADUA, FEAST DAY - JUNE 13



Fernando Martins was born in Lisbon, Portugal in 1195, into a wealthy family and by the age of fifteen asked to be sent to the Abbey of Santa Cruz in Coimbra, the then capital of Portugal. When Franciscan friars settled a small hermitage outside Coimbra dedicated to Saint Anthony of Egypt, Fernando felt a longing to join them and received permission to leave the Abbey so he could join the new Franciscan Order. When he was admitted, he changed his name to Anthony. He was sent by St. Francis of Assisi to preach and to teach his fellow friars in Bologna and then in Padua, Italy. He was only 35 years old when he died and

was canonized less than one year afterwards by Pope Gregory IX in 1232. Upon exhumation some 336 years after his death, his body was found to be corrupted, yet his tongue was totally incorrupt, so perfect were the teachings that had been formed upon it. He is the Patron Saint of Lost Things.
