#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

In this Gospel reading, we witness Jesus healing a man who was deaf and had a speech impediment. Jesus' compassionate touch, saying "Ephphatha" (which means "Be opened"), restores the man's hearing and speech. This miracle reflects the boundless love and mercy of Christ, who not only heals physical ailments but opens hearts to hear God's word and speak His truth.

The passage invites us to reflect on our own openness. Are we listening to God's voice in our lives? Are we speaking words of love, kindness, and faith? Just as Jesus physically healed this man, He also desires to spiritually open our hearts and lives to His transformative power. Let us trust in His healing touch and share His message of hope with others.
