## **Gospel Reflection**

In Mark this week's Gospel, a rich man asks Jesus what he must do to inherit eternal life. While he has followed the commandments. Jesus invites him to take a further step giving up his wealth to follow Him. The man's sadness at this request reveals how tightly he clings to his possessions. Jesus teaches that it is difficult for the wealthy to enter the kingdom of God because attachment to material things can cloud our vision of God's greater purpose. This passage greater than anything we could possess in calls us to examine what we hold dear and

challenges us to let go of anything that hinders our complete trust in God. True wealth, as Jesus explains, is not measured by earthly standards but by our ability to live generously, humbly, and dependently on Him. When we surrender ourselves and give in charity, we store up treasures in heaven—receiving more than we could ever give up. Following Christ may require sacrifice, but the reward is eternal and far this life.
